

TTSI Job Interview Sample Questions

Interviews with district and school personnel typically occur from late-April through mid-July. We will notify you when you are selected for an interview.

Please practice these questions in an interview format with your co-teacher or friends. When responding, use examples and details about how you would use these topics in your classroom, if applicable.

1. Why are you interested working in our district and why are you a good candidate?
2. What parts of teaching you like most? and least?
3. What is differentiated instruction to you?
4. What is your greatest strength and weakness?
5. Two things you will implement in your class. (You may mention positive discipline and data driven instruction)
6. How do you handle irate parents?
7. What is your approach to classroom management? (This question is very important!)
8. How do you measure student success?
9. How do you deal with conflicts with staff members, students, and stakeholders?
10. What will I see in your classroom when I walk in? (Describe your class/classroom and instruction)

If the interviewer asks whether you have any questions for them, you may ask about teacher support, any professional development, or mentoring that will help you improve. You may also ask about the specific programs the schools use for instruction.
